



Tura Embedded

Tura Embedded offers a unique opportunity for donors (of \$5,000+) to have a lived-in experience of one of Tura's Regional Programs, becoming steeped in the practice and witnessing the cultural outcomes of those Programs – this is embedded philanthropy.

In 2019, Tura Embedded will offer five opportunities for Champion* and above donors. Below summarises those opportunities, all offering the unique experience of time spent with creatives on country as well as the entrée to community, only afforded through this process.

* Champion donors contribute at a level of \$5,000.

1. **Sonus Tour**

2 – 8 July 2019

Touring artists: Judith Hamann, Aviva Endean, Naomi Pigram and Mark Atkins.

- 2nd Arrive in Broome.
- 3rd Drive to Beagle Bay - schools workshop and performance.
Drive on to Cape Leveque for Kooljaman accommodation and on-country event.
- 4th Cultural Tour with Bardi Elders and private Sonus performance.
- 5th Visit One Arm Point with cast and crew for a schools performance and cultural tour.
- 6th Community concert at Lombadina with local artists.
- 7th Drive to Broome. Evening performance on-country with star man Greg Quicke.
- 8th Fly home or to Perth for Perth concert on July 9.

Max 6 Tura Embedded participants.

2. **Bambula Tour**

The latest development in the ongoing collaboration between Wagilak songmen from Ngukurr and Paul Grabowsky – Bambula – featuring the Wilfred Brothers, Paul Grabowsky and Erkki Veltheim.

a. **Ngukurr Section**

10-17 October 2019

- 10th Arrive in Darwin.
 - 11th - 14th Ngukurr N.T. with on country experiences, concerts and corroboree.
 - 14th - 16th Katherine including concert and schools presentations.
 - 16th - 17th Darwin including the concert at Darwin Entertainment Centre.
- Max 4 Tura Embedded participants (100% ALLOCATED).

Tura Embedded 2019 cont'd.

b. Darwin-Broome section

16-24 October 2019

- 16th Arrive in Darwin for the concert at Darwin Entertainment Centre.
17th - 20th Kununurra for on-country cultural event; collaborative performance at Waringarri Aboriginal Arts, schools presentations, and cultural tours.
20th – 22nd Broome for concert and cultural tours.
22nd Fly home.
Max 6 Tura Embedded participants (2 remaining).

c Port Hedland-Perth section

23 – 29 October 2019

- 23rd Arrive Port Hedland for community concert and schools presentation.
24th Travel to Karratha for concert at Hearsons Cove.
25th - 27th Community engagement/concert in Roebourne.
27th Travel to Perth.
28th Perth concert at State Theatre Centre of WA.
29th Travel home.
Max 4 Tura Embedded participants.

3. Gillian Howell Residency (Final week)

14 – 20 September 2019

Five days in Fitzroy Crossing experiencing the final week of Gillian Howell's Residency in Fitzroy Crossing including final performances and on-country experiences, a guided tour of Mangkaja Arts Centre, and attend a workshop with the artists.
Max 4 Tura Embedded participants.

COST

Minimum donation to be eligible for the Tura Embedded program is \$5,000 (Champion donor level and above). All costs associated with the trip including accommodation, transport, meals and additional tours or activities will be at the expense of the participant.

PROVISO

NB1: The minimum participation numbers for each Tura Embedded opportunity is 2 participants (or a min. of \$10,000 in donations). This could be two couples.

NB2: All of the above program information is subject to confirmation and should number of Tura Embedded participants not be sufficient, the trip may be subject to cancellation.
